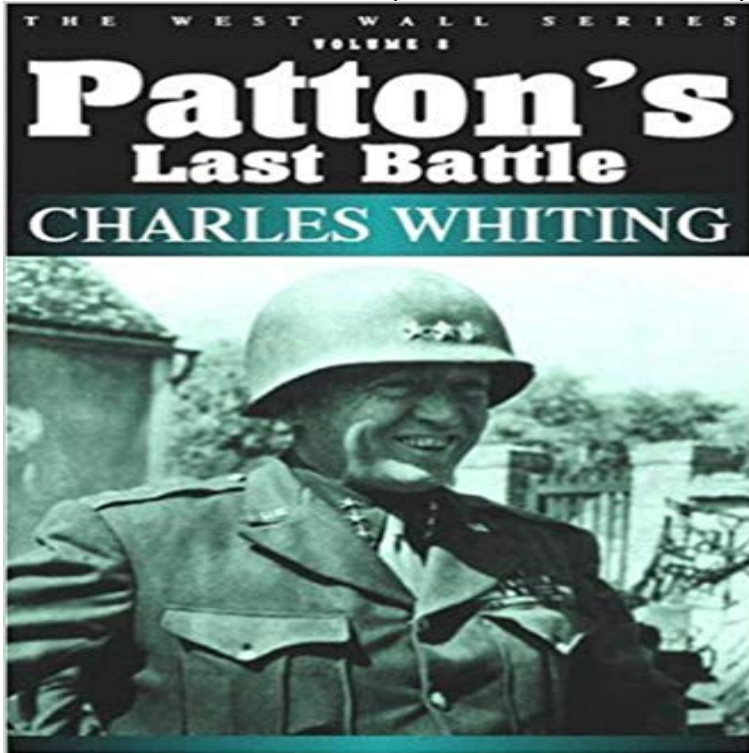


Pattons Last Battle (West Wall Series)
